#### ПРЕДИСЛОВИЕ

Данное учебное пособие рассчитано на широкий круг лиц, изучающих английский язык. Основная цель практикума — знакомство с традициями англоязычного мира и манерами поведения в кафе, ресторанах, на приемах. Учебное пособие знакомит слушателей со спецификой разговорной речи в ситуациях реального общения.

Цель учебного пособия – развитие адекватного использования английского языка в ситуациях бытового общения, связанных с посещением кафе, ресторанов, приемов гостей и т.д.

Работа содержит конкретную лингвострановедческую информацию по данной теме, наиболее употребительную лексику и серию упражнений, ориентированных на отработку коммуникативных навыков.

In most countries East or West eating out has now become very popular. A lot of eating places ranging from high-class restaurants to factory canteens serve for all tastes at various prices.

Normally a meal in a restaurant takes time. Usually you tell the waiter what you want for first two courses; he will take your order for dessert and coffee later. When paying the bill it is customary to tip waiters, however in most restaurants a service charge is nowadays added to avoid individual tipping. If you want to have a quick lunch you may decide on a snack-bar, a café or even your office vending machine where you can get sandwiches and other snacks.


